

AGISTMENT CONTRACT FOR BREEDING AND RELATED SERVICES

Welcome to Oatesdale Park,

Thank you for your interest in using Oatesdale Park Services for your mare. We provide a quality specialised agistment and veterinary service in conjunction with Adelaide Plains Equine Clinic for your mare during the breeding season. Our aim at Oatesdale Park is to provide your mare with the best of care and attention during the time in which your mare is here for breeding purposes in order to facilitate the best possible outcome of a positive pregnancy result for your mare.

During your mares stay at Oatesdale, she will be provided with 24 hour supervision with electric fenced yards and paddocks. Quality feed and shelter, supervised care and handling will be provided by the proprietor or her direct staff when deemed necessary. During the mares stay she will be teased when required and scanned according to the breeding policies and procedures outlined to you by Adelaide Plains Equine Clinic (APEC). When a breedable follicle is detected, the semen to your chosen stallion will be ordered by APEC.

By signing this agreement the mare owner agrees to and has read all the conditions set out in the contract without prejudice.

Terms and Conditions:

- The mare owner has the right to visit their mare on the property with prior arrangements being made with the proprietor/owner.
- The mare owner has the right to expect quality safe care for her mare whilst residing at Oatesdale Park, however the mare owner agrees to indemnify the property owner/proprietor for any accident or illness that may occur to their mare. All care will be taken, but no responsibility for any loss or injury that may result from any procedure relating to breeding of the mare, nor any accident or illness that may occur. Any related expenses will be solely the responsibility of the mare's owner and they will be charged directly by the treating vet.
- **HANDLING FEE** : A once off handling fee will be charged to each mare bought to Oatesdale Park for the purposes of breeding. This handling fee covers all handling of the mare for any procedure deemed necessary by the attending vet for the purpose of attaining a successful outcome of any AI procedure. All teasing procedures, documentation and teasing charts, and any other handling of the mare whilst at Oatesdale Park , shall be covered by this once off fee for the current breeding season. IF the mare for some reason does not go in foal and has left the property but returns during the same breeding season, the mare owner is not required to pay another handling fee. IF however the mare returns the following season due to no foal. The handling fee will be payable again. This fee must be paid on booking your mare, before the mare arrives at the property.

- **Agistment fees/bond:** The mare owner agrees on signing this contract, to pay an upfront bond (agistment in advance) This must be paid before the mare comes to Oatesdale Park or on arrival to the property. This agistment/bond fee is deductible from your final agistment account. All agistment fees and related charges must be paid in full before the mare will be allowed to leave Oatesdale Park.
- **The mare owner undertakes to inform the proprietor of intention to arrive or depart from the property with the mare, with reasonable notice (ie at least two days)**
- All mares must be safe to handle and tie up, Oatesdale Park reserves the right to refuse any mare that is unruly or hard to handle, or arrives in a condition that is not acceptable.
- The mare owner understands that all veterinary procedures are carried out by APEC vets and staff, whose accounts, policies and procedures are separate to this contract. Please refer directly to the clinic for these.



FEES AT OATESDALE PARK 2012:

Dry Mares

\$10/day shared paddock

\$12/day private paddock (if available)

Mares with foals

\$12/day shared paddock

\$14/day private paddock (if available)

All of the above prices include appropriate hay feeds.

Mares that require extra feed (particularly under heavy lactation) are given a hard feed daily as required, at increased cost after consultation with the owners.

A once off handling fee of \$220 is payable for each mare agisted.
